Commercial Ewes, Market Lambs, Wool Sheep, Breeding Does, Market Goats, Dairy Goats, Beef Heifers and Market Steers

1. If fewer than six (6) head of any breed are entered for more than one year (2 years), they will be shown in all other registered breeds division. If more than six (6) head are exhibited one year and are entered the next they will be split back out into their own breed show.
2. Please be prepared to show a copy of your registration papers for all registered stock (or a copy of the paper where you have applied for the registration papers).
3. There will be NO substitutions, changes, or additions after entry deadline.
4. All exhibitors are limited to ONE animal per class, except where classes are broken by weight.
5. All shows are limited to 2 head per exhibitor.
6. All shows are open to the following counties: Stokes, Forsyth, Surry, Yadkin, Guilford, Rockingham counties in NC. Patrick and Henry, counties in VA. You must be a full time resident in these counties.

ENTRIES

- Entries must be postmarked by September 1st. Please keep a photocopy of your entries.
- All youth exhibitors' ages are determined by their age as of January 1 of the current year.
- **SHOW MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO LIMIT ENTRIES BASED ON SPACE**
- **EXHIBITORS ARE LIMITED TO TWO HEAD PER SHOW.**

- There shall be NO substitutions, changes or additions after entry deadline.
- **JUDGES' DECISION WILL BE FINAL**

HEALTH REGULATIONS

Health regulations will be strictly enforced, and decisions of the regulatory veterinarian concerning animal health status are final. No animals may be unloaded on the fairgrounds before checked and approved by a vet on site. All livestock exhibitors must have health certificates, and the required test. See entry requirements for each species. All species must follow specific entry requirements listed under each class rules and regulations. All entries shall be inspected prior to unloading. Any and all animals not meeting the entry requirements and/or exhibiting any signs of disease or illness, may be refused entry, required to be isolated and/or required to be returned to the farm of origin. Any and all animals exhibiting any signs of disease or illness or found not to have met entry requirements after entry may, likewise, be required to be isolated and/or returned to the farm of origin.

PREMIUM COLLECTION

- **PREMIUMS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR PICK UP IN THE BARN 30 MINUTES FOLLOWING THE SHOW. AN ANNOUNCEMENT WILL BE MADE TO ALL EXHIBITORS THAT THEY MUST PICK UP PREMIUMS FROM AN EXTENSION AGENT FOLLOWING THE SHOW.**

SHOWMANSHIP

Showmanship classes are based on age of exhibitor as Jan. 1 of the current year.

- Novice: any youth 7 and under
- Junior: any youth 8-10 years old
- Intermediate: any youth 11-13 years old
- Senior: any youth 14-18 years old
- Super Senior: any youth 19-21 years old
- Gifted: (any age individual with special needs, difficulties or handicaps.)
- Showmanship classes will proceed in the following order: Gifted, Novice, Junior, Intermediate, Senior, Super Senior
- Exhibitor must designate on the entry form that they wish to participate in Showmanship. Only registered exhibitors will participate, except for gifted showmanship
- Showmanship participants must be listed as the exhibitor of that animal to show.

Lambs

1. All lambs must meet NC health requirements.
2. All lambs must have an ear tag or tattoo number.
3. Lambs can be wethers or ewes. (NO RAMS)
4. Ewe lambs can be shown in both market and ewe show.
5. Each exhibitor is limited to two lambs per show.
6. Lambs must be dry at weigh-in.
7. Check-in/Arrival Time: 2PM.
8. Lambs must be checked in by 4PM.
9. Show Time: 5:00PM (starting with showmanship, ewes, market, wool)
10. Lambs will be released at the end of the entire show.

Goats

1. All goats must meet NC health requirements.
2. All goats must have an ear tag or tattoo number.
3. Goats must be wethers or does. (NO BUCKS)
4. Does can be shown in both market and doe show.
5. Each exhibitor is limited to two goats per show.
6. Goats must be dry at weigh-in.
7. Check-in/Arrival Time: 2PM.
8. Goats must be checked in by 4PM.
9. Show Time: 5:00PM (starting with showmanship, does, market, dairy)
10. Goats will be released at the end of the entire show.

Cattle

1. All cattle must meet NC health requirements.
2. All cattle must have an ear tag or tattoo number.
3. Each exhibitor is limited to two head per show.
4. Check-in/Arrival Time: 11AM.
5. Cattle must be checked in by 2PM.
6. Show Time: 3:00PM (starting with showmanship, heifers, steers)
7. Cattle are released after the completion of the entire show.
8. Cattle must be halter broken. All unruly animals will be asked to leave the ring.
9. Steers must be dry at weigh-in.
10. Cattle must be heifers or steers. (NO BULLS)
